PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All parade entrants must pre-register with the OACC. Entries require an adult signature.

2. Line-up will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Furtaw Field. Please use the Lake Street entrance and don't arrive earlier. A rolling start may be used to encourage space between groups both within the parade line-up and on the street. Social distancing will be expected and encouraged.

3. "ILLUMINATED" is the key word, whether walking or riding in a decorated vehicle or on a float. Battery operated lights or "quiet" generators are acceptable. For walkers, battery-operated lights are suggested.

4. The parade route is U.S. 23 south to Mill Street west. You are asked not to turn off before Mill Street. Please proceed with caution, as vehicles will move slowly to complete stops to ensure that walkers are accounted for and off the streets or safely inside vehicles prior to existing the designated Parade Route/Right of Way areas.

5. No loose hay or straw, kerosene lanterns or open flames of any kind. One current 5lb ABD dry chemical extinguishers must be carried and accessible on each float. Gauge must be in the green area.

6. ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING CANDY OR ANY ITEMS FROM FLOATS OR VEHICLES! This is an endangerment to all children and adults alike, especially in the dark.

7. NO HEADLIGHT BEAMS ON DURING THE PARADE. Parking lights, emergency flashers and decorative lighting only. All entrants are encouraged to have holiday music, singing or instruments.

8. Santa may be attending the parade. PLEASE REFRAIN FROM ADDITIONAL SANTAS AS IT TENDS TO CONFUSE THE CHILDREN.

9. Please keep the safety and health of others in mind when participating. Participants are encouraged to maintain cautionary measures and to adhere to all guidance and directives relative to Covid-19 risks and cautions.

10. SLOW DOWN! Keep 20' between you and the group ahead of you and pause at intersections.
